



## **2023 Archery Manitoba Provincial 3D Team Program**

### **1. Introduction**

This program document serves to outline team eligibility criteria, timelines and expectations of archers interested in participating.

### **2. The intent of the Archery Manitoba Provincial Team Program is:**

- a. To strive for excellence, provide our athletes the means and avenues to achieve our goals.
- b. To prepare Manitoba Archers to compete in Provincial, National, and international events.
- c. To Identify/Select a pool of archers to field teams for Canadian Championships, Major Domestic Events & International Competitions.
- d. To provide sufficient Support and development opportunities for archers dedicated to the Provincial Team Program.
- e. To promote the sport of archery.
- f. To be a positive ambassador for Sport Manitoba and the Archery Manitoba.

### **3. Provincial 3D Team General Criteria**

- a. The Provincial Team Program is open to all Archery Manitoba Members in good standing *and* who are permanent residents of Manitoba. Manitoba Archers attending a post-secondary institution outside Manitoba are eligible to apply for the Provincial Team.
- b. Team members will demonstrate commitment to the team by attending team meetings, practice sessions, and fundraising events when called to do so.
- c. Applications must define the archers' shooting category based on the Archery Canada categories for the entire season.
- d. A parent or guardian must accompany Team members under 14 years of age to go to out of Province events (Guardian/Parent is self-funded) (exceptions Canada Games, Western Canada Summer Games etc.).
- e. Archery Manitoba participation in Provincial Indoor & Outdoor 3D Championships is mandatory for all team members. Archers can be exempt from participating with written consent from the program leadership if submitted at least 14 days prior.
- f. Team Members are required to own a current Archery Manitoba Provincial Team Uniform. Individuals that are accepted to the team for the first time may be eligible to receive one shirt from the Archery Manitoba free of charge.
- g. Archery Manitoba Team uniforms must be worn at provincial, national, and state championships during opening, closing and medal ceremonies. Team uniforms must also be worn for the duration of competition on the first day of competition for all funded events. Failure to comply will result in loss of funding for that event.
- h. Team members must submit a signed copy of the Athlete Agreement, Team Registration Form, Team Registration fee by the annual deadline.
- i. Travel and accommodation arrangements may be made by the Archery Manitoba for qualified Provincial Team Members attending funded events, who are traveling and staying with the team. All other travel arrangements/costs are the responsibility of the individual Team Member.
- j. Funding amounts will be determined by the 3D Committee and approved per event.



#### **4. 2023 Archery Manitoba 3D Team Squads**

##### **a. 2022 Youth Team**

The goal of the Archery Manitoba 3D Youth Team is to support and encourage Cub & Cadet aged archers to participate in local 3D events, while working to grow their skills and progress in the sport. The focus will be on encouraging participation in local events, and the Archery Manitoba Provincial championships. Team resources include Event Flighting with archers of similar skill level, access to program development clinics and team training sessions, as well as discounted rates at all Archery Manitoba sanctioned events. Youth Team Members will be eligible for fee discounts to 2022 Manitoba Games Training Sessions.

Youth Team Selection Criteria:

The qualifying period is January 1, 2022 – October 1, 2022

Achieve a combined average 'Youth' Minimum Qualifying Score at any 3 Archery Manitoba Club, Indoor 3D Championship, or Outdoor 3D Championship.

***Team Registration Fee \$100***

##### **b. 2022 Regional Team**

The goal of the Archery Manitoba 3D Regional Team is to support and develop team members who wish to grow their involvement in 3D beyond local events. The focus will be on encouraging competition in Club Level events, Archery Manitoba Provincial championships, and select regionally important events in SK, AB, and ND.

Team resources include access to provincial program development and high-performance training clinics, access to team training sessions. Opportunity to participate in team fundraising activities, and access funds raised to attend select funded events. Regional Team Members are eligible funding to program identified developmental events outside Manitoba.

Regional Team Selection Criteria:

The qualifying period is January 1, 2022 – October 1, 2022

Achieve a combined average 'Regional' Team Minimum Qualifying Score criteria at 3 Archery Manitoba Sanctioned events during the qualification period and participate in the Provincial Indoor and Outdoor 3D Championships.

***Team registration fee \$150***

##### **c. 2022 Elite Team**

The goal of the Archery Manitoba 3D Elite Team is help develop and enable team members to compete at Canadian National Championships, major domestic events and select international events. The focus will be on encouraging elite competition, in Manitoba and beyond, up to and including 3D National/International major events.

Opportunity to participate in team fundraising activities, and access funds raised to attend select funded events. Elite Team members can also submit a request to access to Sport Manitoba Sport Psychologists, Nutritionists, and Strength Training. Team members are eligible to apply for funding to compete in select National/International 3D Major events. Elite team members will be eligible to participate in program development and high-performance training camps throughout the season.

Elite Team Selection Criteria:

January 1, 2022 – October 1, 2022



Achieve a combined average 'Elite' Team Minimum Qualifying Score criteria at 3 Archery Manitoba sanctioned qualifiers during the qualification period, including the Indoor and Outdoor 3D Provincial Championships. One of the qualifying scores must be from the Provincial Indoor or Outdoor 3D Championships.

**Team registration fee is \$250.**

## 6. Minimum Qualifying Scores

Scores must be submitted to Archery Manitoba Office as part of the team registration document. To be eligible for team resources, Provincial Team Members are required to compete in the category & class in which they qualified.

Final Qualifying Scores for all Categories will be based on complete event score (40 Targets for smaller events, 80 targets at Nationals) Elite level funding is reserved for the highest participated/most competitive Categories in each age group.

Categories not specified in the Qualification Schedule will not be funded.

### **Additional Funding Criteria**

#### *World Archery 3D Championship*

Athletes qualifying as a member of the Canadian National 3D Team for the World Archery 3D championships will be eligible to apply to receive a \$1000.00 grant for attendance at the World Archery 3D championship.

*Note: All Provincial Team Grants are dependent upon funding, shall be reviewed annually and may be subject to change throughout the year.*

## **6. Qualifiers**

**Archery Manitoba will schedule 4 sanctioned qualifiers, including Provincial Championships in 2022. The qualifier events will be confirmed as stand alone or partner events, following the completion of the 2022 Outdoor Event Registration. Archery Manitoba's intention is to host the qualifiers on the following weekends:**

- April 15 – 17, 2022 - Canadian Indoor 3D Championships – Lac La Biche, Alberta
- May 1, 2022 – Manitoba Provincial Indoor 3D Championships – MacGregor, Manitoba
- June 17 – 19 – National Team Selection Trials – Lac La Biche, Alberta
- June 26 – 27 Wing Archery Club - Winnipeg, Manitoba
- July 10 – Deloraine Game & Fish 3D – Deloraine, Manitoba
- July 15 – 17 Canadian Outdoor 3D Archery Championships – York, PEI
- August 7 – Flatlanders Archery Club – Sanford, Manitoba
- August 28 – Provincial Championships – Fort La Bosse Wildlife – Virden, Manitoba
